value of one shilling, which he in his right hand then and
there held and held, the said Richard Clatterbuck, feloniously,
voluntarily, maliciously and of purpose did strike, in and upon the body
of him the said Richard Clatterbuck, with intention in so doing,
feloniously, voluntarily, maliciously and of purpose, to maim,
disfigure, disable and kill him the said Richard Clatterbuck, against
the form of the Statute in such case made and provided, and against
the peace and dignity of the Commonwealth

And the jurors aforesaid upon their oaths aforesaid, do further present
that the said ~~Richard Clatterbuck~~ Shennon on the same day and year
aforesaid to wit on the 1st day of May in the year 1837 at
the County aforesaid and within the jurisdiction of this Court, with
force and arms, in and upon one Richard Clatterbuck, then and
there being, feloniously and unlawfully, did make an assault, and
that the said Alexander Shennon with a certain knife, of the
value of one shilling, which he the said Alexander Shennon
then and there in his right hand held and held, feloniously and
unlawfully did strike the said Richard Clatterbuck, in and upon the
body, just above the right hip bone, about the iliac region
