on this oath aforesaid further persons, that a certain William Robins was, on the
day and year aforesaid, at the County aforesaid, and within the jurisdiction of
this Court, on purpose, maliciously and contumaciously, did disturb the said
congregation so assembled as aforesaid, and whilst engaged in worship in the meet-
ing house aforesaid, by throwing himself with violence and force against the door
of the said meeting house, which was then and there ^{shut}, and also by declaring that he would
break open the door of the said meeting house against the ~~power~~ ^{will} of the ~~interests~~ ^{and} of the
~~Legislature~~ Assembly of Virginia in this case made and provided and against
the peace and dignity of the Commonwealth of Virginia.
