THE grand jurors, summoned for the commonwealth of Virginia from the body of the county of ~~Page~~, upon their oaths present that <sup>Rockingham</sup> Robert Hooke late of the said county, on the 7<sup>th</sup> day of <sup>October</sup> ~~October~~ in the year of our Lord, one thousand eight hundred and ~~thirty fourth~~ <sup>forty eighth</sup>, was surveyor over the precinct of the public road from ~~Beacons~~ <sup>in the middle of the Chesapeake river opposite New Haven passing through the town and ending where it intersects the Harpersburg and Port Republic road</sup> at the county aforesaid, and within the jurisdiction of this court: and the grand jurors aforesaid, upon their oaths aforesaid, do further present that the said Robert Hooke surveyor as aforesaid, of the precinct of the public road as aforesaid, on the said ~~seventh~~ day of <sup>October</sup> ~~October~~ in the year of our Lord one thousand eight hundred and ~~thirty fourth~~ <sup>forty eighth</sup>, at the county aforesaid, and within the jurisdiction of this court, did not then and there cause the road aforesaid, within the precinct aforesaid, to be constantly kept well cleared and smoothed, and thirty feet wide, (no order of court entered of record having authorised the road aforesaid to be of less width than thirty feet,) within six months last past, contrary to the act of the general assembly in such case made and provided, and against the peace and dignity of the commonwealth.

This indictment is founded upon the evidence of <sup>Robert Ewan</sup> one of the grand jurors sent by the grand jury into court and sworn in court to give wisdom to the grand jury.
