

Hanover Judicial Circuit Rockingham County to wit
In the circuit court of said County. The jurors of the Commonwealth
of Virginia in and for the body of the County of Rockingham and
now attending the circuit court of said County upon their oaths
present that Abbot Nicholas on the 1st day of August 1857 at the
said County (be the said Abbot Nicholas then and there being
the surveyor of that part of a certain road leading from the top of
Hite's hill in the said County to opposite the house in said County and
in precinct No 7) did not as such surveyor on that day cause
that part of the said road to be kept clear, smoothed of
rocks and obstructions of the occupancy width, well drained and
otherwise in good order, and secure from the falling of dead timber
therein; but did on that day and divers other days between that day
and the day of making this presentment, and whilst he was surveyor
as aforesaid suffer that part of said road to be and remain
for a long space of time obstructed and in bad order and insecure
from the falling of dead timber thereto, against the peace and
dignity of the Commonwealth. This indictment is found on the
evidence of Benjamin Ewing one of the grand jury sworn in court to give
evidence before the grand jury.
