smoothed of Rocks and of obstructions and of the necessary
width, to wit the width of thirty feet, well drained
and otherwise in good order and secure from the falling
of dead timber therein, but did on that day and at that
time and divers other days and times, between that
day and time and the day of ^{the} finding ~~that~~ this undrained
and whilst he was surveyor as aforesaid, suffer that part
of the ^{said} road to be and remain for a long space of time
obstructed and in bad ~~repairs~~ and insecure from the falling
