day two times and the finding of this indictment and whilst he was surveyor
as aforesaid, suffer that part of the said road to be and remain for a
long space of time obstructed and in bad order and insecure from
the falling of dead timber thereon to the great damage of all the good citizens
of the Commonwealth passing that way against the peace and
dignity of the Commonwealth of Virginia
