necessary width, to wit of the width of thirty feet, well drained and otherwise
in good order and secure from the falling of dead timber thereon, but did on that
day and at that time and divers other days and times, between that day and time and the
finding of this indictment and whilst he was surveyor as aforesaid, suffer that part of
the said road to be and to remain for a long space of time obstructed and in bad order
and insecure from the falling of dead timber thereon to the great damage of all the good citizens
of this Commonwealth passing that way against the peace and dignity of the
Commonwealth of Virginia.
