The Jurors of the Commonwealth of Virginia in and for the body of the County of Rockingham and now attending upon said Court upon their oaths present that John Blankenship on the day of April in the year one thousand Eight Hundred & Fifty eight in the said County of Rockingham divers single bills for the payment of money to wit: one single bill for the payment of One Hundred and Twenty one dollars and sixty eight cents signed by P. Liggette the maker thereof, one other single bill for the payment of Eight dollars and forty four cents signed by one John R. O'Neal the maker thereof, one other single bill for the payment of one hundred and five dollars and seventy nine cents signed by one Stephen J. Few the maker thereof and one other single bill for the payment of One Hundred and sixty six dollars ~~thirty~~ seven cents signed by John Messerly the maker thereof, in the whole amounting to the sum of Four Hundred and two dollars and forty two, eight cents and of the value of Four Hundred and Two dollars and twenty eight cents, the said single bills at the time of committing the felony aforesaid being the property of one T. J. Butler and the said sum of Four Hundred and Two dollars and ~~forty~~ eight cents, payable and secured by and upon said single bills being due and unsatisfied to the said T. J. Butler the owner & proprietor thereof feloniously did take, steal and carry away, against the peace and dignity of the Commonwealth of Virginia

2- And the Jurors aforesaid on their oaths aforesaid do further present that John Blankenship on the day and year aforesaid in the said County of Rockingham one single bill for the payment of One Hundred and Twenty one dollars and sixty eight cents and of the value of one hundred and Twenty one dollars and sixty eight cents signed by one P. Liggette the maker thereof, the said single bill at the time of committing the felony aforesaid being the property of T. J. Butler and the said sum of One Hundred & Twenty one dollars and sixty eight cents, payable and secured by and upon said single bill being due and unsatisfied to the said T. J. Butler the proprietor thereof feloniously did steal, take and carry away, against the peace and dignity of the Commonwealth of Virginia

3^d And the Jurors aforesaid on their oaths aforesaid do further present that John Blankenship on the day and year aforesaid in the County of Rockingham aforesaid one pocket book of the value of one dollar of the goods & chattel of one T. J. Butler thus and thence being found, feloniously did steal, take and carry away, against the peace and dignity of the Commonwealth of Virginia

4th And the Jurors aforesaid on their oaths aforesaid do further present that John Blankenship on the day and year aforesaid and in the County of Rockingham aforesaid one pocket book of the value of one dollar of the goods & chattel of one T. J. Butler divers boards single bill for the payment of money and of the value of Eight hundred dollars, the property of the said T. J. Butler and the said sum of Eight hundred dollars payable and secured by and upon said single bill being due and unsatisfied to the said T. J. Butler the proprietor thereof, thus and thence being found, feloniously did steal, take and carry away, against the peace and dignity of the Commonwealth of Virginia

We the Jury find the person so guilty in
an manner & form as is accused in the
first Count in the indictment and
fix the term of his imprisonment in
the penitentiary at three years and we
find him not guilty on the other
Counts, except the indictment

Digges the maker thereof. one other single bill for the payment of \$8.44 & of the value of \$8.44 signed by Jno R. O'neal the maker thereof. one other single bill for the payment of \$105.79 and of the value of \$105.79 signed by Stephen J. Few the maker thereof and one other single bill for the payment of \$166.57 and of the value of \$166.57 signed by one John Meperly the maker thereof. the said single bills the property of Thomas J. Butler. and are unsatisfied to the said Thomas J. Butler Present

The said John Blankenship was led to the bar in custody of the Sheriff of this County, and sundry witnesses being sworn and examined touching the premises. the Court upon mature deliberation are of opinion that a felony has been committed. and that there is probable cause to charge the said John Blankenship therewith. it is therefore ordered that he be remanded for trial before the Circuit Court of this County on the first day of the next term thereof. and thereupon the prisoner was remanded to jail.
