oaths aforesaid do further present that George Fawcett
on the day & year aforesaid in the County aforesaid

did make and him the said Jacob R. Brathwaite
did then & there beat, wound and ill treat and
other wrongs to him then and there did to the
great damage of him the said Jacob R. Brathwaite
and against the peace and dignity of the

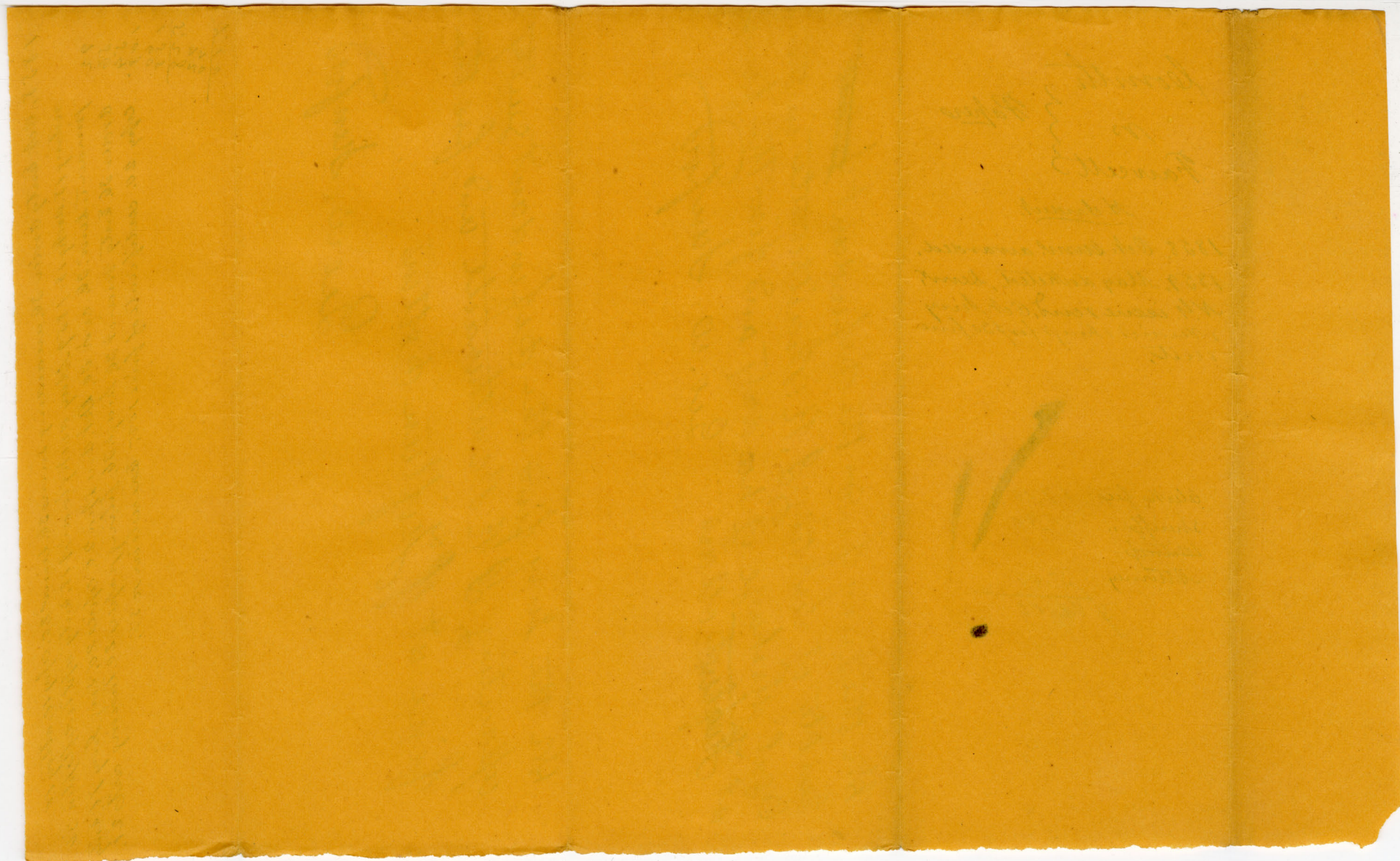
