as such Surveyor on that day cause that part of
said road to be kept clear, smoothed of rocks &
obstructions, of the necessary width, well drained,
and otherwise in good order and secure from
the falling of dead timber thereon, but did on
that day and divers other days between that day
and the day of the finding of this indictment
and whilst he was Surveyor as aforesaid suffer
that part of the said road to be and remain
for a long space of time obstructed and in
bad order and insecure from the falling of
dead timber thereon, against the peace & dignity
of the Commonwealth of Virginia

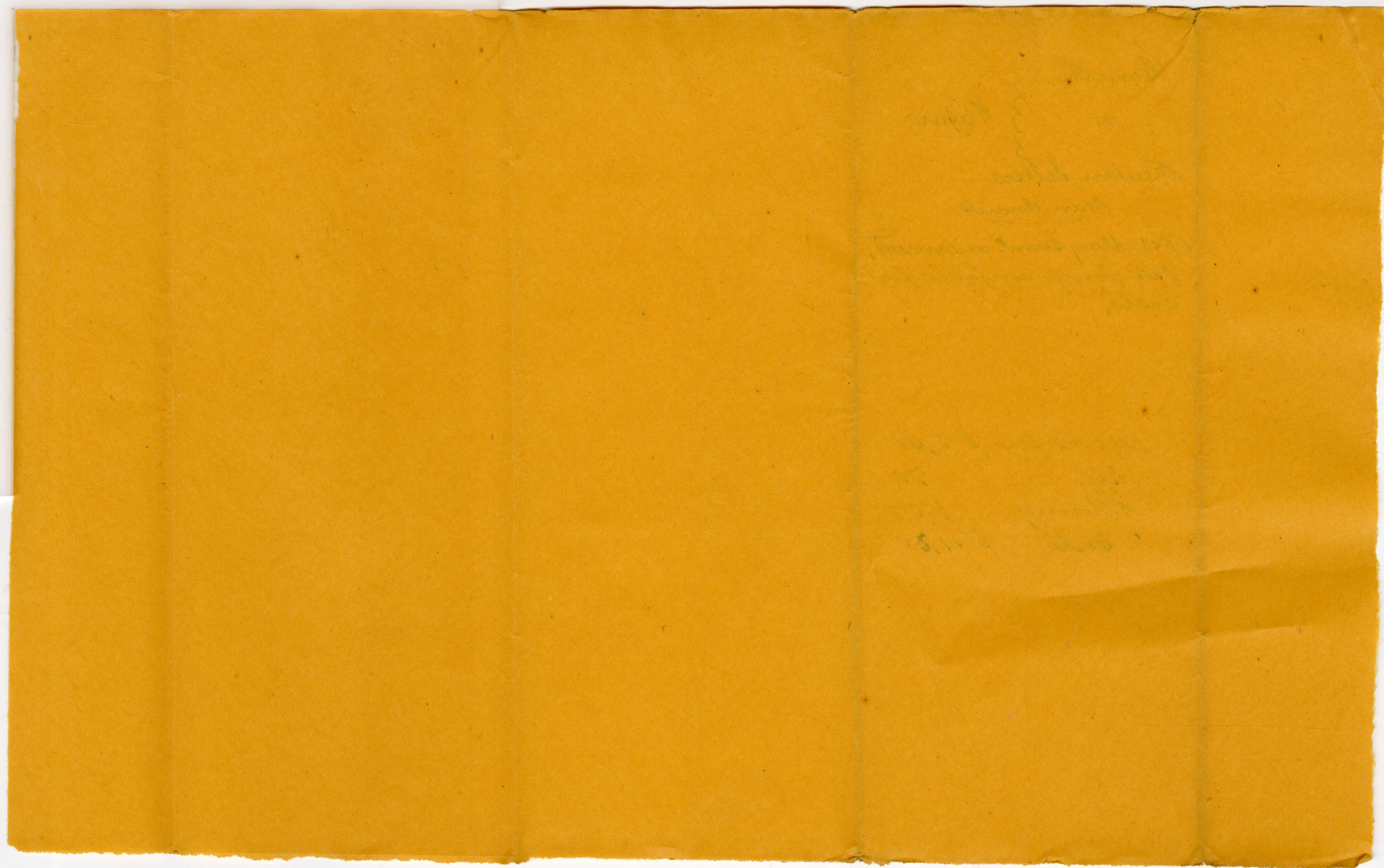
