Stonetter a white person on the 1st day of August in the year one thousand eight hundred and sixty in the County aforesaid with force and arms in and upon one Julia Ann Keyser a female white person of the age of thirteen years and more to wit of the age of thirteen years feloniously did make an assault And her the said Julia Ann Keyser then and there to wit on the day and year aforesaid at the County aforesaid feloniously did ravish and carnally know against her will and by force against the peace and dignity of the Commonwealth of Virginia

This indictment is found upon the oath of Julia Ann Keyser Anna Smith Catharine Sawatts, ^{David G. Lamb.} witnesses sworn in court and sent before the grand jury to give evidence
