Commonwealth of Virginia And the jurors aforesaid on their oaths aforesaid
do further present that the said *Thomas More* on the *1st* day of *March*
in the year *1861* in the said County *unlawfully did* *Guerrilla* *Shooter*
an insane slave *then* under his control to go at large
without adequate provision for his support against the
peace and dignity of the Commonwealth of Virginia
This indictment is found upon the testimony of *Richard*
A. Shuman a witness sworn in Court and sent before the
Grand Jury to give evidence
