

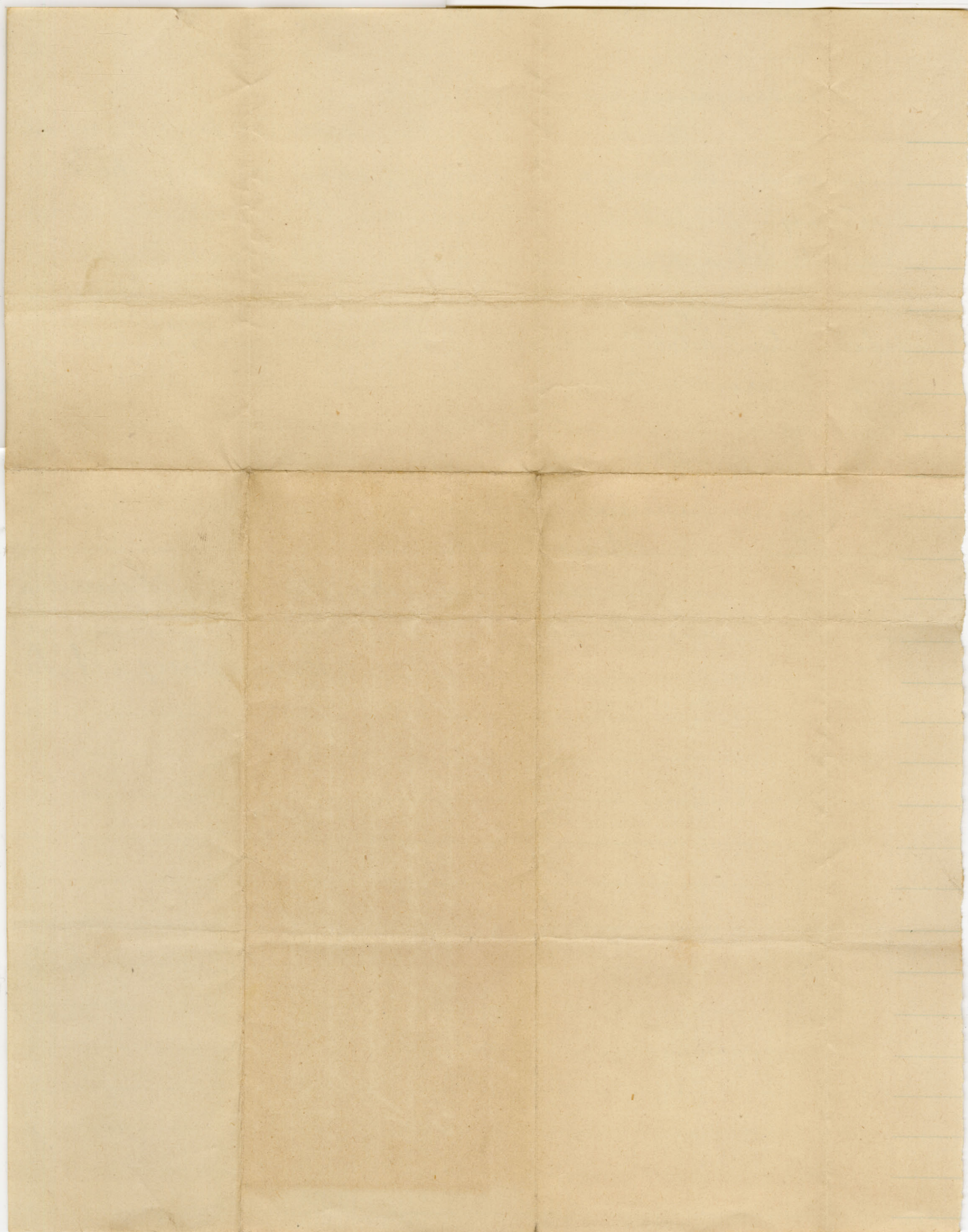

No calculations need be gone into in filling up the final statement, but the dates should in every instance be accurately given. The effects left by deceased soldiers and officers should be turned over to the regimental or post quartermaster and his receipt therefor sent to the Second Auditor. It is not necessary to make duplicates of final statements.
