Campbell on the day of in the year 1862, at his distillery in said County, did make and cause to be made, unlawfully, whiskey, and other spirituous and malt liquors, out of corn, wheat rye and other grain - which said whiskey and other spirituous and malt liquors were not made ^{for medicinal or hospital purposes} in execution of a bona fide contract, ~~before~~ that made before the time of such manufacture of said liquors, with the Chief Purveyor of the medical Department of the Confederate States Government, or with the medical Director of the Virginia State Line, against the peace and dignity of the Commonwealth of Virginia.

We further find this Indictment in law of one for the same offence against said James A. Campbell heretofore
