and malt liquors were not made for medicinal
or hospital purposes, in violation of a bona
fide contract, made before the time of the
manufacture thereof, with the Chief Purveyor
of the Medical Department of the Confederate
States Government or with the medical di-
rector of the Virginia State line, against
the peace and dignity of the Commonwealth of
Virginia—

the same offence found against said Joseph
Randall, at a former term of this Court, which
has been returned by the jury—
