Be it remembered that on the 24<sup>th</sup> day August 1865. Thomas Locker and, John Huffman of the said County came before Me Madison Moore a Justice of the said County and severally and respectively acknowledged themselves to be indebted to the Commonwealth of Virginia in manner and form following that is to say the said Thomas Locker in the sum of One Thousand Dollars and the said John Huffman One Thousand Dollars, to be respectively made and levied of their several goods and chattels, lands and tenements, to the use of the Commonwealth of Virginia if the said Thomas Locker shall make default in performance of the condition under written.

The condition of the above recognizance is such that if the above named Thomas Locker do and shall personally appear before the Justices in Harrisonburg on the 3<sup>rd</sup> day of September 1865. then and there to answer the Commonwealth for and concerning a certain felony by him committed in fellowship, Mary and take to wife one Mary Ella Henry Collihuys of County of Madison (Va.) where with the said Thomas Locker stands charged and shall not depart thence without the leave of the said Court, then the above recognizance shall be void else to remain in full force and virtue.
