goods and chattels of the said Abraham Leick
in the said out-house then and there being found
felamously to steal take and carry ^{away} and one crack
of Budding of the value of five dollars of the goods and
chattels of the said Abraham Leick and one piece of soap
of the value of one dollar of the goods and chattel
of the said Abraham Leick in the said out-house
then and there being found then and there feloniously did
steal take and carry away against the peace and dignity
of the Commonwealth of Virginia

Mr. Mc Coy found the prisoner John W. Coakley guilty of the felony charged in the indictment, and assessed the term of his imprisonment in the Penitentiary at one year.

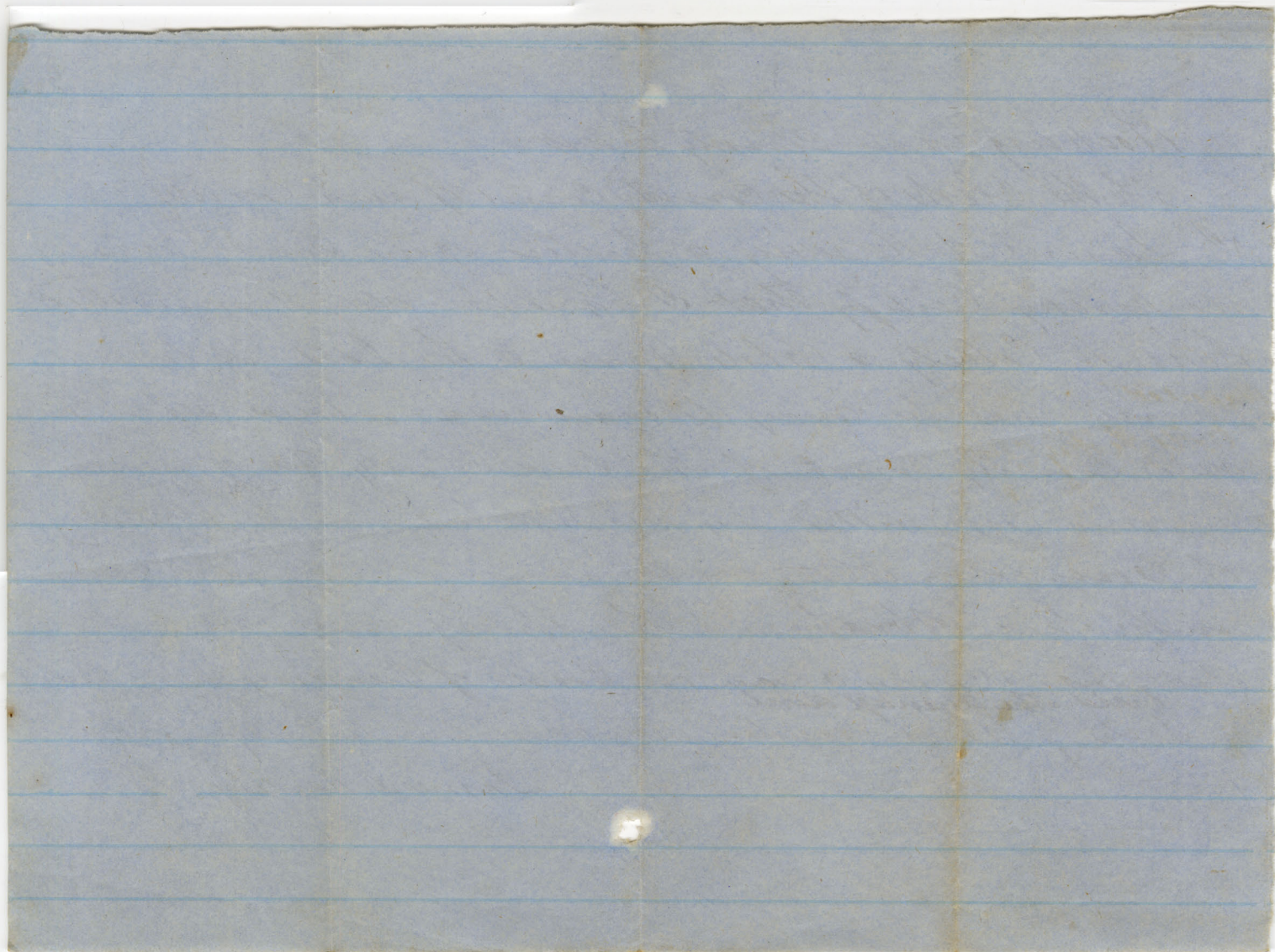
