Emanuel Lawson, Moses Lawson, Agatha
Marshall Wm^r D. Maiden Louis Coleman
Mr^r ^{Belgeen} Lawson - & John Coleman on the part
of the defendant, of the said County,
personally appeared before me
Wm^r S. Miller a Justice of said County
& each of them separately & indi-
vidually, acknowledged themselves re-
spectively & individually to be indebted to
the Commonwealth of Va in the
sum of one hundred dollar,
to be levied of each of their goods
& chattels, land & tenements, to the use
of the Commonwealth if the said
above named parties shall make de-
fault in the performance of the con-
ditions underwritten.

The condition of this recognizance is
such, that if the above bound parties
& every & each of them, shall personally
appear before the County Court of said
County at a special term on the 12th day
of June 1866. to give evidence in behalf
of the Commonwealth & in behalf of the
defence, in a case of felony in the name
of the Commonwealth vs John Seaton
charged with the killing of Newton Shiflett

in the month of March 1865; & do not
depart thence without the leave of the
Court. Thus this Recognizance to be
void, otherwise to remain in full
force & virtue.

gunpowder & leaden shot feloniously
& of his Malice aforethought did
shoot in said County Alfred Shiflett
with intent him the said Alfred
Shiflett then & there to maim, dis-
figure, disable & kill. & being of
opinion that there is sufficient cause
for charging the said John Dean with
