said county, on the oath of J. N. Gordon, with a  
felony by him committed, in this, that the said  
William Kyle, in the night of the 8th day of  
December, 1866, in the said County, the dwell-  
ing-house of Mrs. Harriet Hanen, did feloniously  
and burglariously break open and enter, and  
two hundred and fifty pounds of Pork, of the  
value of \$20, of the goods of the said Harriet  
Hanen, did then and there feloniously and bur-  
glariously take, steal and carry away from  
the said dwelling-house. And you, the said  
Keeper of the said jail, are hereby required to  
receive the said Wm. Kyle, alias William ~~~~~  
into your jail and custody, that he may be ex-  
amined for the said offence by the County Court  
of said County, and him then safely keep until he  
shall be discharged by due course of law. Given
