Rockingham County To Wit:-

To F. M. Flick, Constable R. County

Whereas, Hugh Morrison of the said County, has this day made complaint and information on oath before me, George S. Christie, a Justice of the said County, that Alice Eastham <sup>freed negro</sup> of the said County, on the 14<sup>th</sup> day of February, 1856, in said County did, feloniously take, steal and carry away a pocket Book, belonging to said Morrison containing twenty Dollars and fifty cents.

These are therefore, in the name of the Commonwealth, to command you forthwith to apprehend and bring before me or some other Justice of the said County, that body of the said Alice Eastham to answer the said complaint, and to be further dealt with according to law. Given under my hand and seal, this 15<sup>th</sup> day of February, 1856.
