Whereas Alexander Simmons of Said County  
has this day made Complaint and infor-  
mation, on Oath, before me, ~~W. S. Schmitt~~ a  
Justice of the Said County, that Addison  
4 Workmen <sup>and Henry S. Berry</sup> on the 14 day of June 1867 in  
Said County, did unlawfully, maliciously  
and feloniously, Stab Cut and wound, the  
Said Alexander Simmons, with intent to  
maim, disfigure, disable and kill, him the  
Said Alexander Simmons.

Thus are, therefore  
in the name of the Commonwealth, to Com-  
mand you forthwith to apprehend and bring  
before me, or some other Justice of the Said  
County the body of the Said Addison 4 Work-  
men <sup>and Henry S. Berry</sup>, to answer the Said Complaint, and  
to be further dealt with according to law.
