Be it remembered that on this 15th day of June 1867 Josiah F. Silvious and Jonas Early & William Silvious of said county came before me Martin Garber a Justice of said county and severally acknowledged themselves to owe to the commonwealth of Virginia that is to say, The said J. F. Silvious the Sum of Two hundred Dollars and the said Jonas Early & William Silvious the Sum of Two hundred to be respectively made & levied of their several goods & chattels lands & tenements, if the said Josiah F. Silvious shall make default in performance of the conditions underwritten, —

The condition of the above recognizance is such, that whereas the above named J. F. Silvious has been arrested and this day brought before me Martin Garber a Justice as aforesaid, accused upon the oath of Amanda Silvious an unmarried white woman of being the father of a male ^{bastard} child whereof she was delivered on the 29th day of January 1866 in the said county, now if the said J. F. Silvious shall make his personal appearance before the next county court of said county, on the first day of the ^{next} term thereof, to abide the order of said court touching the said accusation, and shall not thence depart without the leave of the said court, then the above recognizance to be void, otherwise to remain in full force and virtue Taken and acknowledged before me this 15th day of June 1867—


