

Rockingham County, to wit:

In the Circuit Court of said County,

The Jurors of the Commonwealth of Virginia in & for the body of the County of Rockingham and now attending the said Court upon their oaths present that Peter Roller on the 1st day of July 1806 (at the said County) (be the said Peter Roller then & there being the surveyor of that part of a certain road leading from the Valley Turnpike in the said County to Freedens Church in the said County and in Precinct No 7) did not as such surveyor on that day cause that part of said road to be kept cleared, smoothed of rocks, and obstructions, of the necessary width, well drained, and otherwise in good order, and secure from the falling of dead Timber therein, but did on that day & divers other days between that day and the day of making this Indictment and whilst he was surveyor as aforesaid suffer that part of the said road to be and remain for a long space of time obstructed and in bad order and incumbered from the falling of dead Timber therein, against the peace & dignity of the Commonwealth of Virginia.

This Indictment is made upon the oaths of John Cateharr and Peter Wilhite, witnesses sworn in Court & sent to the Grand Jury to give evidence.
