^{& also inside S^d Church}
as to disturb the order and solemnity
of the Meeting there are therefore in
the name of the Commonwealth to
Command you forthwith to

Apprehend and bring before me
or some other justice of the S^d County
The body of the S^d Williamth Saufley
to answer S^d Complaint and to
be further dealt with according
to Law given under my hand and
seal this the 7th day of October
1867

the sum of twenty five dollars and The said
Wm. Saufley sen in the sum of twenty five
dollars to be respectively made and levied
of there several goods and chattels lands and
tenements to the use of the Commonwealth
of Virginia if the said Wm. Saufley of George
shall make default ⁱⁿ ^{performance of the} ^{conditions of the} ^{above recognizance}
The conditions of the above Recognizance is
such That if the above Bound Wm. Saufley
of George do and shal personally appear on
the first day of the Feb^r term 1868 Before the County
Court of the said County at the Courthouse
there of and then and there answer a bill
of indictment to be preferred to the grand
jury and for the said County against him
The said Wm. Saufley of George for a misde-
meanor by him committed fore willfully
and unlawfully disturbing an assembly met
for the worship of god ^{at Spradys Grove church} whereof the said Wm.
Saufley of George stands charged and shal
not there depart without the leave of said
court then the above recognizance shal be
void and of no effect
