

Rickingham County To Wit

John Gungwer of the said County came personally before me Peter S. Roller a Justice of the said County on this 13th day of August 1867 and made complaint on oath that Thomas C. Grinn did on Sunday the 11th day of August in the said County throw stone at said Gungwer and further threatened and said that he would give him a Beating and that he would give it to him some day when he caught him said Gungwer out and the Grinn having made similar threats about the commencement of Harvest by reason whereof he this complainant is afraid and has good cause to fear that the said Thomas C. Grinn will do him some grievous bodily injury and therefore prays he may be required to give security to keep the peace toward him and the said John Gungwer also says on oath that he does not make the complaint against the said Thomas C. Grinn nor require such security from any hatred malice or ill will but merely for the preservation of his person from injury.

Whereas as John Genger has this day complained on oath before me P. S. Roller a Justice of said County that Thomas C. Griner of the said County did on the 11th day of August 1867 threaten that he would give him a Beating and that he would give it to him some day when he caught him out and having made similar threats about the commencement of harvest. and has required surety of the peace of the said Thomas C. Griner, I command you in the name of the Commonwealth of Virginia forthwith to apprehend the said Thomas C. Griner and to bring him before me or some other Justice of said County to answer the said Complaint
