hereby certify that I have this day admitted
Milton Sealill to appear before the Hustings
Court of the said Corporation on the first day of
January term thereof to answer an indict-
ment in the said Court, for a misdemeanor
by him committed, in this, that he did, on
the day of 1868, in the said Corpora-
tion, unlawfully assault and beat Thomas
Loyal. Given under my hand this
day of 1868.

To-wit:-

Be it remembered, that on this ~~2^d day of November~~, 1868, Milton Grabill and J. P. Effinger, of the said county, personally came before me, J. L. Eibert, Mayor of said town, and severally acknowledged themselves to be indebted to the Commonwealth of Virginia, in the manner and form following, that is to say: The said Milton Grabill in the sum of \$450, good and lawful money of the United States, and the said J. P. Effinger in the sum of \$450, of like good and lawful money, to be respectively made and levied of their several goods and chattels, lands and tenements, to the use of the Commonwealth of Virginia, if the said Milton Grabill shall make default in the performance of the underwritten condition.

The condition of the above recognizance is such, that if the above bound Milton Grabill do and shall appear on the 4th day of January 1869, before the Justices Court of the Corporation of Harrisonburg, at the Court house thereof, and there and there answer a bill of indictment, to be preferred to the grand jury in and for the said Corporation, against him the said Milton Grabill for a misdemeanor by him committed, for unlawfully assaulting and beating one Thomas Loyal, whereof the said Grabill stands charged, and shall not thence depart without leave of said court, then the above recognizance shall be void and of no

Effect, therein to remain full force and
virtue.
