that Henry Raines on the 4<sup>th</sup> day of September  
in the year 1869. with force and arms,  
in the County aforesaid, in and upon the body  
of one John M O'Connell in the peace of  
the Commonwealth of Virginia then and  
then being, feloniously, unlawfully and of his  
malice aforethought, did make an assault  
and the said Henry Raines gave of the value  
of two dollars, then and then charged with gun-  
powder and one leaden bullet; which said  
gun he the said Henry Raines in his two  
hands then and then held and held, then  
and then feloniously, unlawfully and of his  
malice aforethought did discharge and  
shot off, to, against and upon the said  
John M O'Connell and that the said Henry  
Raines with the leaden bullet aforesaid, out of  
the gun by the said Henry Raines discharged  
and shot off, as aforesaid, then and then  
feloniously, unlawfully and of his malice afore-  
thought, did strike penetrate and wound the  
said John M O'Connell in and upon the head  
and body of him the said John M O'Connell  
giving to him, the said John M O'Connell

then and then with a leaden bullet af-  
 -said, so as aforesaid discharged and  
 shot out of the gun aforesaid, by the said  
 Henry Raines in and upon the head  
 and body of him the said John M O'K  
 onnell one mortal wound of which  
 said mortal wound he the said John  
 M O'K onnell from the said 4<sup>th</sup> day of Sep-  
 -tember in the year aforesaid to the day of  
 September in the year aforesaid, in the  
 County aforesaid, did languish and lang-  
 -uishing did live; on which said day of  
 September in the year 1869. The said John  
 M O'K onnell in the County aforesaid, of  
 the said mortal wounds aied; and so the  
 jurors aforesaid, upon their oaths aforesaid  
 do say that the said Henry Raines, the said  
 John M O'K onnell in manner and form  
 aforesaid, feloniously, wilfully and of his  
 malice aforethought, did kill and murder  
 against the peace and dignity of the Common-  
 -wealth of Virginia
