Whereas Samuel Bradwell of the said
County, hath this day made complaint & in-
firmation on oath before me E. J. Sullivan
a Justice of the said County that on the
— day of April 1868. in the said County
there were found, one cotton shirt, three
linen table cloths, eight linen napkins, one
white linen chemise, marked G.W. one old
corset, one pair yellow cotton drawers one
white skirt, one Gents shirt, one small
child's shirt ruffled, one Pillow case one
red silk handkerchief with white letter S.
one same, one tin wash pan. of the goods
and chattels of him the said Samuel Bradwell
were feloniously taken stolen and carried away
from him by one John Solomon and that
he hath just cause to suspect, and doth
suspect that the said goods are concealed in
the dwelling house of the said John Solomon
in the said County: There are therefore to
authorize and require you, in the name of
the Commonwealth of Virginia with necessary aid
to enter in the day time the said dwelling house
of the said John Solomon and there diligently
search for the said goods, And if the same
or any part thereof shall be found upon

such much, that you bring the said
grasses and across the body of the said John
Solomon before me or some other justice
of the said County to be appraised of and sold
with according to law. Given under
