forthwith to convey and deliver into the Custody
of the Keeper of the said Jail to gether with
this Warrant the body of John Collever charged
before me J. Price a Justice of the said Town
on oath of A. St. C. Sprinkle with a felony
by him committed, in this, that the said
John Collever on the 9th day of August in
the year 1869 in the County of Rockingham
did three hatters of the Value of six dollars
one Collar of the Value of two dollars and fifty
Cents one pair of Lines of the Value of two
dollars and one pair of Buckbunds (for
Cart) of the Value of two dollars and one
Sack of the Value of seventy five Cents
of the goods and Chattles of A. St. C. Sprinkle
feloniously did steal take and carry away
and you the said Keeper of the Jail are
hereby required to receive the said John
Collever into your Jail and Custody that
he may be ~~tried~~ ^{tried} for the said offence
by the Court of Hustings of the said Town
and him there ~~shally~~ keep until he shall
be discharged by due Course of Law
