In the Circuit Court for Rockingham County.

The Jurors of the Commonwealth of Virginia in and for the body of the County of Rockingham and now attending the said Court upon their oaths present that James Carter on the day of August 1874 and from that day until the day of January 1875 in the County aforesaid, did lewdly and lasciviously associate and co-habit with one Sally Banks. The said James Carter and Sally Banks not being married to each other, during all the time aforesaid, against the peace & dignity of the Commonwealth.

This indictment is made in the presence of Annie Carter & Eugenia Brown witnesses sworn in open Court and sent before the grand jury to give evidence.
