the Judge of the County Court at its next
term to answer an indictment to be preferred
against in said court for threatening to kill
the family of John Rinehart and to burn
the property of said Rinehart in the said
county. After the payment of the fine &
cost and giving P. M. Pugh as surety in
the sum of two hundred & fifty dollars
the said Benj. Cabbage was discharged
