Be it remembered that on the 15th day of December 1876. Henry Flemming and John E Roller of the said county came before me Jos Byrd a justice of the said county and severally and respectively acknowledged themselves to be indebted to the Commonwealth of Virginia in manner and form following, that is to say: The said Henry Flemming in the sum of Two hundred dollars and the said John E Roller in the sum of Two hundred dollars to be respectively made and levied of their several goods and chattels, lands and tenements to the use of the Commonwealth of Virginia if the said Henry Flemming shall make default in performance of the condition underwritten.

The conditions of the above recognizance is such that if the above bound Henry Flemming do and shall personally appear before the County Court of Rockingham on the first day of the next term thereof then and there to answer the Commonwealth for and concerning a certain felony by him committed in feloniously stabbing Samuel Edwards wherewith the said Henry Flemming stands charged, and shall not depart thence without the leave of the said court then the above recognizance shall be void else to remain in full force and virtue,

To all or any one of the Constables of said County:

Whereas Thomas L. Edwards of said County, has this day made complaint ^{and information} on oath before me L. C. Whitescarver, a justice of the said County, that Henry Flemming on the 3rd. day of December in the year of our Lord 1876, at a place of Public Worship, in the presence of the congregation met for the worship of God, make an affray, wherein the person of Samuel Edwards was badly cut or stabbed by the said Henry Flemming without any lawful or sufficient ^{cause} given him by the said Samuel Edwards, These are, therefore, in the name of the Commonwealth, to command you forthwith to apprehend and bring before me or some, or some other or some other justice of the said County, the body of the said Henry Flemming, to answer the said complaint, and to be farther dealt with according to law.
