Whereas David P. Rosenberger of said County, has this day
made complaint and information on oath before me
Jacob Funkhouser, a Justice of the said County, that "Add"
Robinson (Colored) on the 11th day of December 1876. in said
County, divers, to wit. ~~Three~~ ~~seven~~ ten dollar note; one
Ten dollar note somewhat worn and one five dollar note
slightly worn, and several one dollar notes and several two
dollar notes, bank notes, for the payment of divers sums of
money, in the whole amounting to the sum of about thirty dollars,
then being the bank notes and property of D. P. Rosenberger & Co.,
feloniously did steal, take and carry away: These are therefore, in
the name of the Commonwealth, to command you forthwith to
apprehend and bring before me, or some other Justice of the said
County, the body of the said Add Robinson colored, to answer
the said complaint, and to be further dealt with according
to Law. Given under my hand and seal, this 13th day
of December, in the year 1876.
