Rockingham County, to-wit:
In the County Court of the said County
The jurors of the
Commonwealth of Virginia, in and
for the body of the County of Rocking-
ham, and now attending the County
Court of the said County, upon their
oath present, that Geo. P. May on the
15th day of January 1876, in the said
County of Rockingham, feloniously
did forge a certain order, purporting
to be signed by one Mrs Mary Hoover,
and which said forged order is
of the following purport and effect
that is to say, "Mr Casore. Please
let this boy have a coat and shirt
Mrs Mary Hoover"
with intent to defraud against the
peace and dignity of the Common-
wealth of Virginia.

And the jurors aforesaid
upon their oath aforesaid, do further
present that the said Geo P. May
afterwards to-wit, on the 15th day of Jan-
uary 1876, in the said County, felon-
iously did utter and attempt to employ
as true a certain other forged order

purporting to be signed by one
Mrs Mary Hoover which said
last mentioned forged order is
of the following purport and
effect.

"Mr Basore Please let this boy
have a coat and shirt"

Mrs Mary Hoover
with intent to defraud, & he the said
Geo. P. May at the time he so uttered
and attempted to employ as true, the
said last mentioned forged order
brought, on the day and year last
aforesaid, at the County aforesaid,
well knowing the same to be forged
against the peace and dignity
of the Commonwealth of Virginia
