Rockingham County to wit:

Be it remembered, that on this 25<sup>th</sup> day of December 1877 Justt Lizer and George M Chapman of said County, personally came before me Jos S. Loose, a Justice of the said County, and severally and respectively acknowledged themselves to be indebted to the Commonwealth of Virginia, in the manner and form following, that is to say: The said Justt Lizer, in the sum of One Hundred Dollars, and the said George M Chapman in the sum of One Hundred, Dollars, to be respectively made and levied of their several goods and chattels, lands and tenements, to the use of the Commonwealth of Virginia, if the said Justt Lizer, shall make default in the performance of the underwritten Condition -

The Condition of the above recognizance is such that if the above bound Justt Lizer, do and shall personally appear on the 21<sup>st</sup> day of January 1878, before the County Court of the said County, at the Court-house thereof, and there and then answer a bill of indictment, to be preferred to the grand jury in and for said County, against him the said Justt Lizer, for a felony by him committed, for unlawfully shooting Noah Sanders, whereof the said Justt Lizer stands charged, and shall not then depart without the leave of said Court, then the above recognizance shall be void and of no effect.
