The Condition of the above obligation is such that if the above bound William E. Layton, do and shall personally appear before the County Court of Rockingham Co., on the first day of the next term of said Court then and there



to answer the Commonwealth of

certain felony with which he

assaulting & wounding H. Clay Phil-  
lips with intent to maim, disfigure,  
disable and kill whereunto the said  
William E. Layton stands charged,
