Alexander is guilty of fornication with the wife of the said James

thereto, 1890; And you the said keeper
of the said jail are hereby required to
receive the said J. W. Alexander - alias
Dr J. W. Alexander - into to your jail and
custody that he may ^{be} tried for the said
offence by the county court of the said

he be discharged by due course of law.
