Whereas Daniel Brown of the said County, has this day made complaint and information on oath before me, J. A. Hammer a Justice of the Peace of said County, that James Price on the 28 day of January in the year 1890 in the said County, did feloniously premeditatedly wilfully and of his malice aforethought attempt to commit the crime of murder, by then and there unlawfully, feloniously, premeditatedly, wilfully, and of his malice aforethought assaulting mistreating administering and causing to be administered to one Fannie Brown, a deadly poison to wit Corbolic acid, or Croston intending thereby her the said Fannie Brown, to feloniously wilfully, premeditatedly and of his malice aforethought to kill and murder, there are therefore, in the name of the Commonwealth, to Command you forthwith to apprehend and bring before me, or some other Justice of the said County, the body of the said James Price, to answer the said Complaint, and to be farther dealt with according to law, given under my hand and seal.
