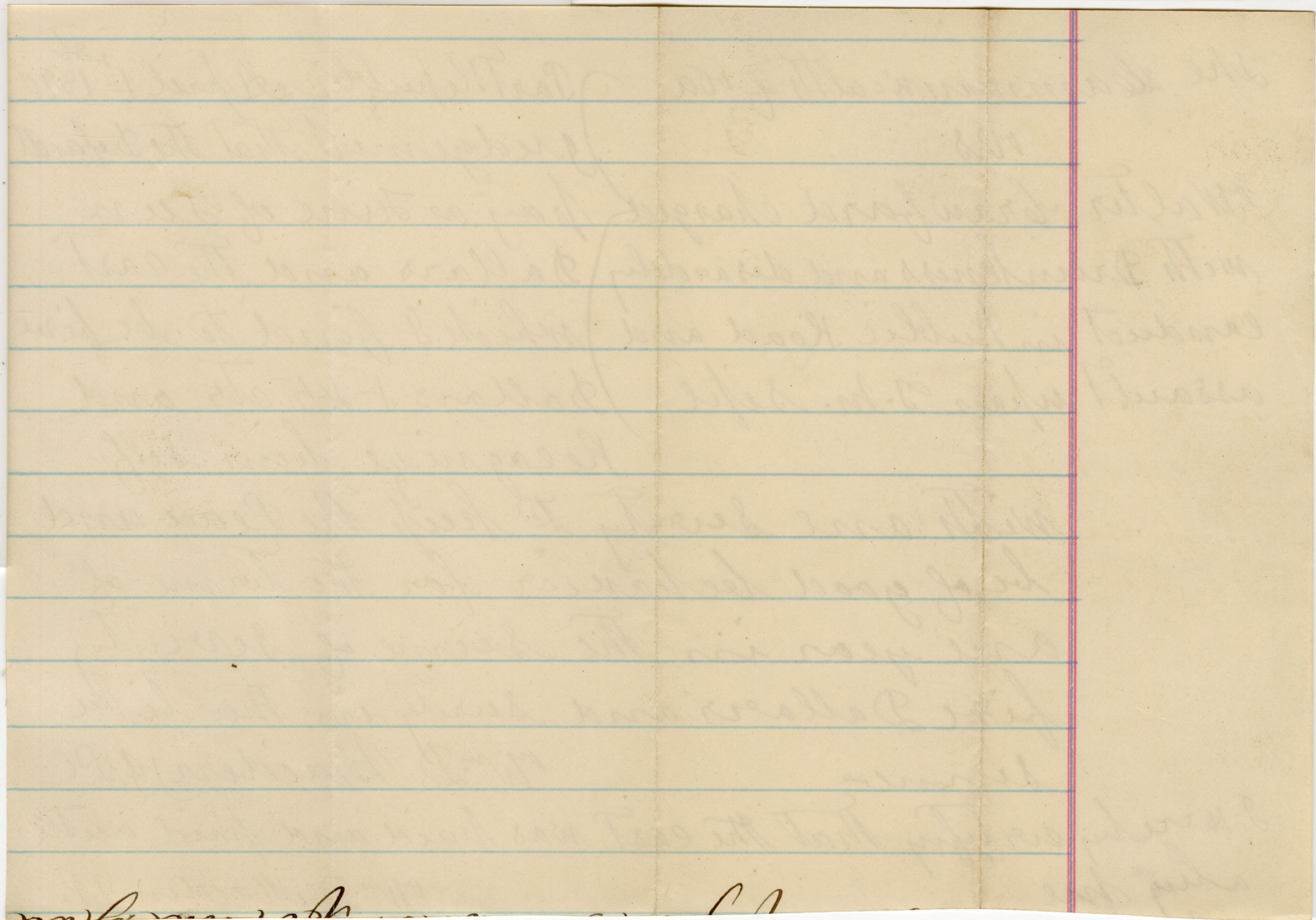

Rockingham County To wit

Be it remembered that on this 1st day of April 1890 Walter Crawford and Noah Rainer & George Crawford of the said County personally came before me Wm. D. Maiden a Justice of the said County and severally acknowledged themselves to owe to the Commonwealth of Virginia that is to say the said Walter Crawford the sum of seventy five Dollars and the said Noah Rainer the sum of seventy five Dollars and the said George Crawford in the like sum of seventy five Dollars to be respectively made and levied of their several goods and chattels lands and tenements if he the said Walter Crawford shall make default in the performance of the condition underwritten -

The condition of the above recognizance is such that if the above bound Walter Crawford shall keep the Peace and be of good behavior towards all the citizens of this Commonwealth and especially towards J. M. Sipe & Family for and during the term of one year from the day hereof then this Recognizance shall be void otherwise to remain in full force and virtue -
