To any one or all of the Constables of said
County -

Whereas Joseph Winegard of the said County
has this day made complaint and information
on oath before me A. C. Rohr a Justice of the
Peace in and for the said County that James
Taylor on the 1st day of July 1890 in the said
County did unlawfully, wilfully, deliberately, pre-
meditatedly, feloniously and of his malice afore-
thought - attempt - to commit - the crime of murder,
by the said James Taylor then & there in and upon
the body of him the said Joseph Winegard, unlaw-
fully, wilfully, deliberately, premeditatedly, feloni-
ously and of his malice aforethought making an
assault - and by the said James Taylor then and
there, with a dangerous weapon called a pistol
loaded with gunpowder and leaden ball, in his hand
then & there held and held, unlawfully, wilfully, deliber-
ately, premeditatedly, feloniously and of his malice
aforethought - shooting off & discharging the said
pistol to and at the body of the said Joseph
Winegard with intent then & there him the said
Joseph Winegard to kill & murder; but - that
he the said James Taylor in the said attempt
to commit the felony & murder aforesaid by
discharging & shooting off the pistol aforesaid

July 14th 1890.

Have heard and accused sent on for indictment
before the Grand Jury at August term of the Richmond
County Court 1890 and to pay costs of Prosecution
which I ascertain to be \$7.90 A. G. Rober J. P.

did not strike or wound the said Joseph Wingard.

There are therefore in the name of the Commonwealth of Virginia, to command you forthwith to apprehend the said James Taylor and bring him before me or some other Justice of the said County to answer the said Complaint, and to be further dealt with according to law.

Be it remembered that on the 19th day of July 1890.

James Taylor. Wiram Roundabush and Humphry Shugrue all of the said County came before me A. L. Rohr a Justice of said County and severally and respectively acknowledged themselves indebted to the Commonwealth of Virginia in manner and form following: That is to say. The said James Taylor in the sum of three hundred Dollars good and lawful money of the United States and the said Wiram Roundabush and Humphry Shugrue each in the sum of three hundred Dollars of like good and lawful money to be respectively made and levied of their several goods and chattels lands and tenements to the use of the Commonwealth of Virginia if the said James Taylor shall make default in performance of the Condition underwritten.

The condition of the above recognizance is such that if the above bound James Taylor do and shall personally appear before the County Court of Rockingham County on the first day of August Term 1890 then and there to answer the Commonwealth for and concerning a certain Felony by him committed for unlawfully - willfully - deliberately - premeditatedly feloniously and of his malice aforethought attempt to commit the crime of murder
