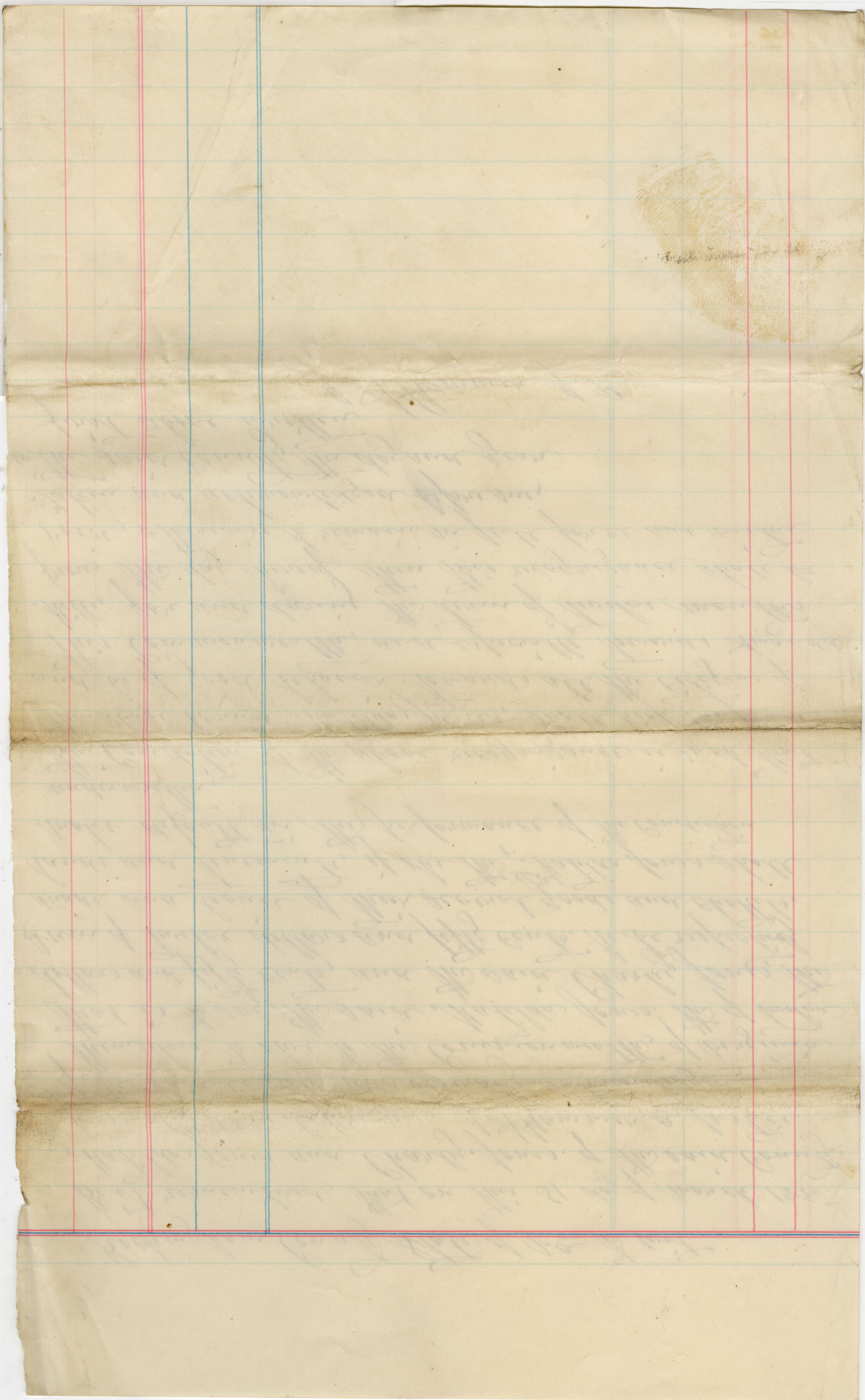


Rockingham County State of Va & wit

Be it remembered, that on this 31 day of March 1895
Matilda Jones and Charly Jones, of the said County
personally come before me, J. A. Hammer, a Justice
of the said County, and severally acknowledged
themselves to owe to the Commonwealth, of Virginia
that is to say the said Matilda Jones the sum of twelve
dollars and fifty cents, and the said Charly Jones the
sum of twelve dollars and fifty cents. to be respectively
made and levied of their several goods and chattels,
lands and tenements, if she the ^{said} Matilda Jones shall
make default in the performance of the Condition
underwritten.

The Condition of the above recognizance is such that
the above bound Matilda Jones, shall keep the peace
and be of good behavior towards all the Citizens of
this Commonwealth, and especially towards Amanda
Mills, for and during the term of twelve months
from the day hereof, then this recognizance shall be
void, otherwise to remain in full force and virtue

To J. M. Coffman Constable of said County
Whereas Amanda Mills. of the said County, has this day
made information and complaint, upon oath, before
me, J. A. Hammer, a justice of the said County, that
Matilda Jones and Sarah Butler. of the said County,
did on the 15th day of March 1890 in the said County,
unlawfully assault and beat her, the said Amanda
Mills. There are, therefore, in the name of the
Commonwealth, to command you forthwith to apprehend
and bring before me, or some other justice of the
said County, the bodies of the said Matilda Jones
and Sarah Butler. to answer the said complaint,
and to be further dealt with according to law
given under my hand and Seal this 17 day of
March 1890 J. A. Hammer J. P.
