formance of the condition underwritten.  
The condition of the above recognizance is such  
that if the above bound Mollie Roben shall keep  
the peace and be of good behaviour towards  
all the citizens of this Commonwealth and espe-  
cially towards Mollie Roben for and during  
the term of one year from the 15<sup>th</sup> day of  
July 1890 to the 15<sup>th</sup> day of July 1891 then  
this recognizance shall be void otherwise to  
remain in full force and virtue.
