Be it remembered that on this 7 day of August
1890, Ella Jenkins, and L. S. Heiston and
David Cabbage, of the said County, personally, came
before me J. A. Hammer, a Justice of the said County,
and severally acknowledged themselves to owe
to the Commonwealth of Virginia, that is to say,
The said Ella Jenkins the sum of ten dollars
and the said L. S. Heiston, the sum of ten dollars
and David Cabbage, the sum of ten dollars,
to be respectively made and levied of their several
goods and chattels lands and tenements, if
she the said Ella Jenkins, shall make default
in the performance of the conditions underwritten,
The condition of the above recognizance is such,
that if the above bound Ella Jenkins, shall keep
the peace and be of good behavior towards ~~all the~~
^{citizens of this Commonwealth} and especially towards ~~A. P. H. H.~~
for and during the term of six months, from the day
hereof, then this recognizance shall be void, otherwise
to remain in full force and virtue,

Whereas, as A. J. Siler has this day complained
on oath, before me, J. A. Hammer, a Justice of
the said County, that Ella Jenkins of the said
County, did on the 25th day of July 1888, threaten
to kill by drawing her knife and swore she
would cut his heart out, and has required
Surety of the peace of the said Ella Jenkins.
I Command you in the name of the Commonwealth
of Virginia, forthwith to apprehend the said

some other Justice of said County, to answer
the said complaint, given under my hand
