above bound Martha J Fauler shall keep the peace and  
be of good behavior towards all of the citizens of this Comm  
onwealth and especially toward Annie M Feltwater for and  
during the term of one year from this date hereof  
then this recognizance shall be void otherwise to remain  
in full force and virtue of our Fauler
