 goods and chattels Lands and Tenements if
 the said Georgeann Randall shall
 make default in the performance of the
 condition under written the condition of the
 above Recognizance is such that if the
 above Georgeann Randall shall keep the
 Peace and be of good behavior towards
 all the citizens of this Commonwealth and
 especially towards W.G. Dawns & R. L. far
 and during the term of one year from
 the date hereof then this Recognizance
 shall be void otherwise to remain in
 full force and virtue and each party
 to this Recognizance waive the benefit of
 their Homesteads as to this obligation
 taken and acknowledged before me in the
 said County the day and year first above
 written W.D. Maiden J.P.C.
