

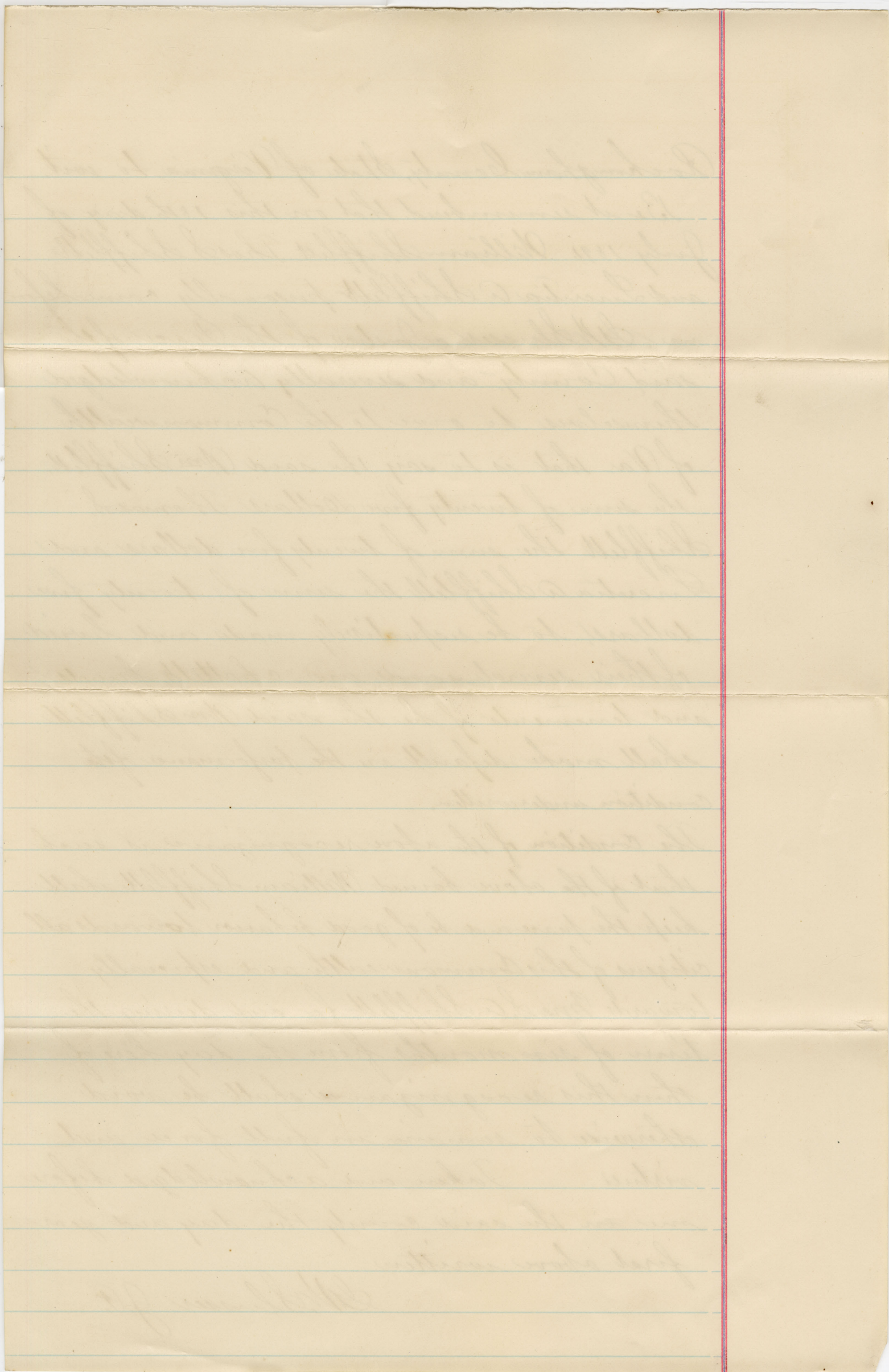
Rockingham County, State of Virginia, to wit.

The condition of the above recognizance is such that if the above bound William Shifflett shall keep the peace and be of good behavior towards all citizens of this Commonwealth and especially towards Mrs. S. A. Shifflett for and during the term of six months from the day hereof then this recognizance shall be void otherwise to remain in full force and virtue.
