If the said Annie C. Hilton shall make default in performance of the condition underwritten.

The Condition of the above recognizance is such that if the above bound Annie C. Hilton do and shall personally appear before The Grand Jury of Rockingham County at the next Meeting thereof then and there to answer the Commonwealth for and concerning a certain felony by her committed in feloniously assaulting Lydia M.

Minnick with intent to maim, dis-
figure^{and} disable or ~~kill~~, where with
the said Annie C. Lytton stands
charged and shall not depart
thence without leave of ~~said~~ the
County Court of said County, Then

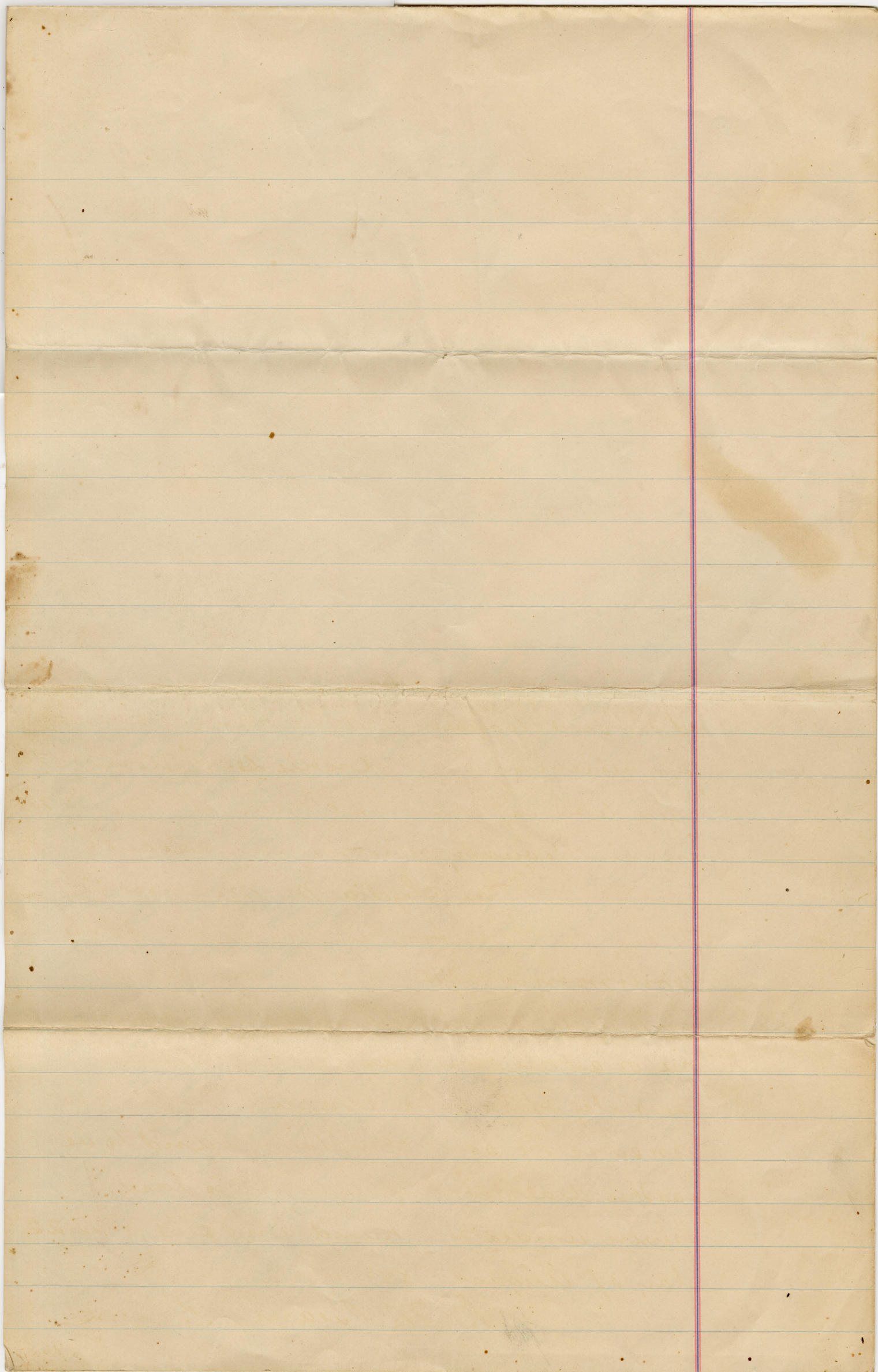

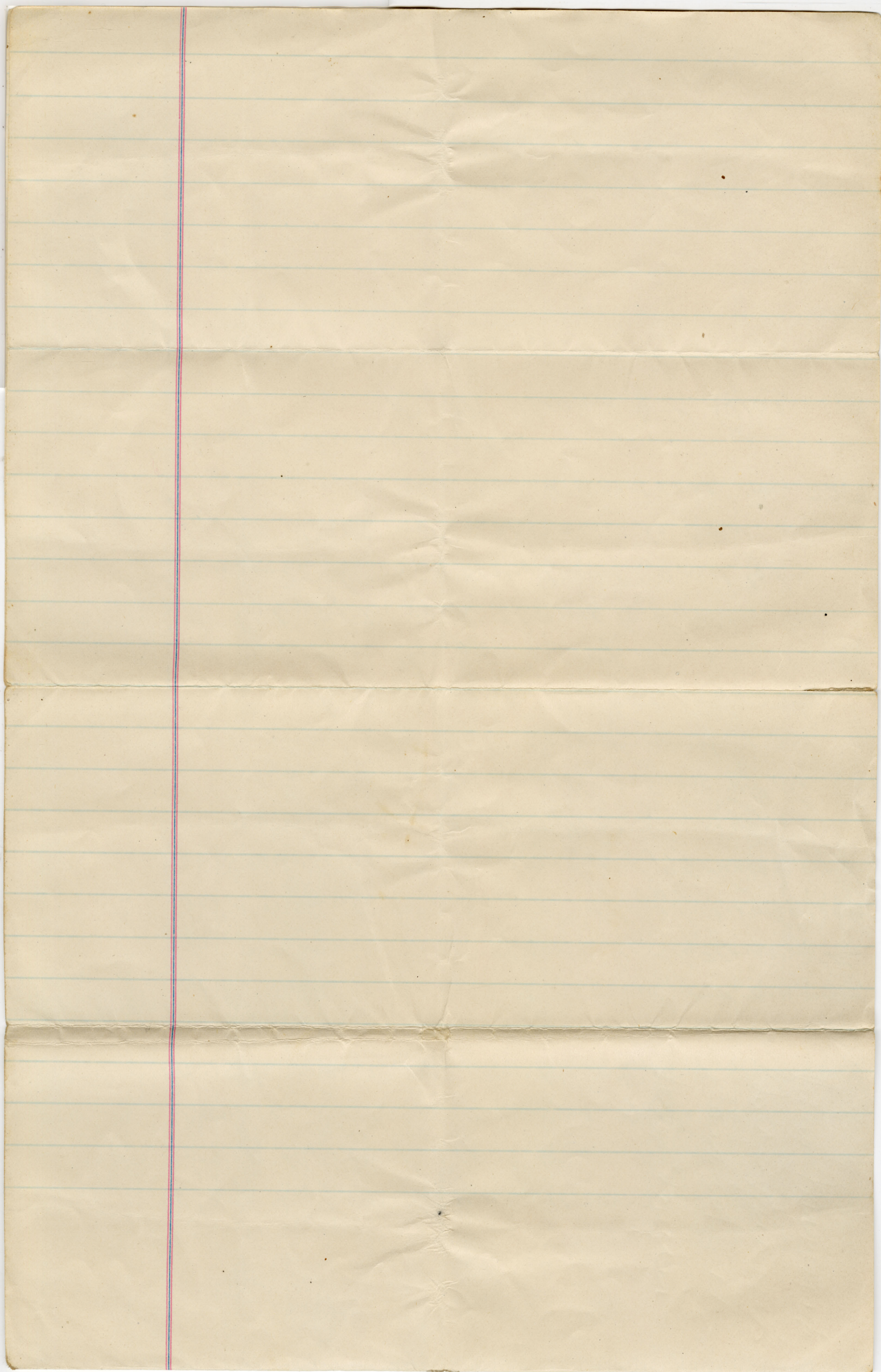
