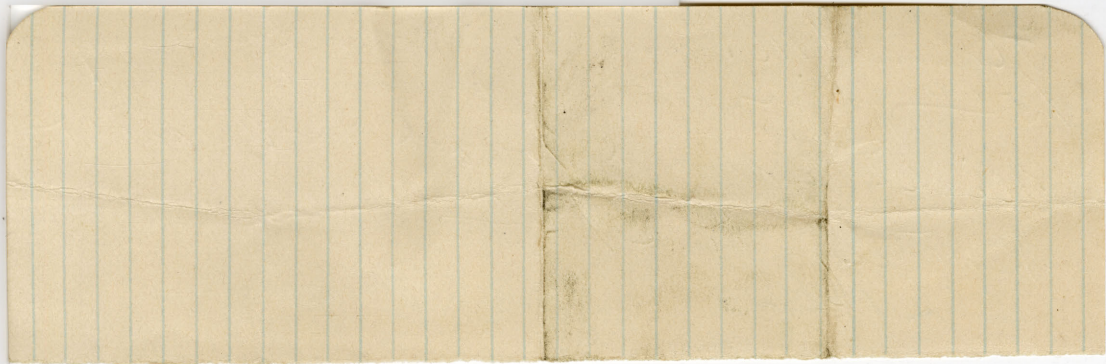


ROCKINGHAM COUNTY, TO-WIT:
