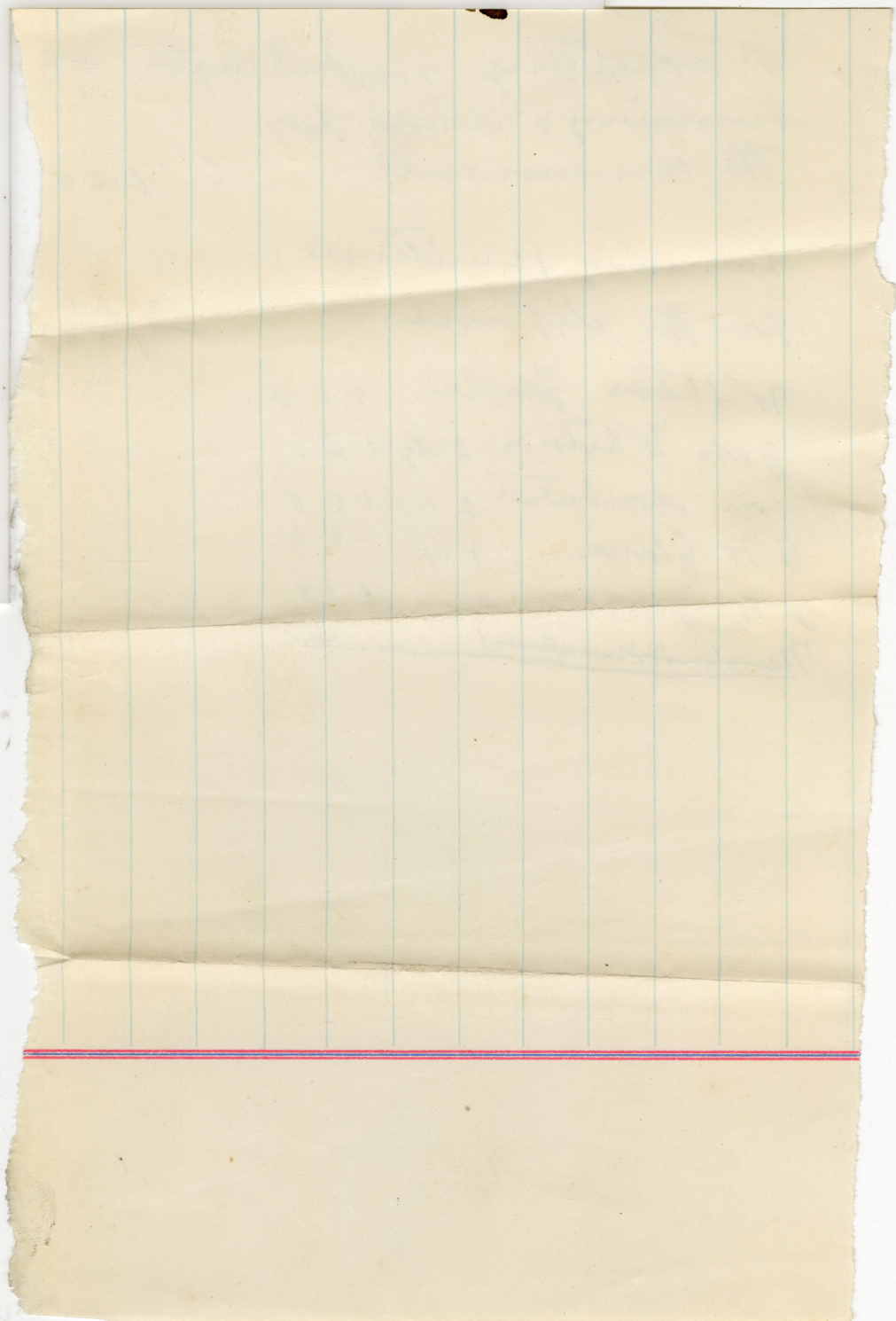

State of Virginia Rockingham County to wit.

To all or any one of the Constables of said County.
Whereas Elizabeth Wirling of the said County
has this day made complaint and information on
oath before me A. C. Rohr a Justice of the
said County that Mary Sheets Celia Wise
and Richard Miller of said County did on the
24th day of October 1894 in said County unlawfully
assault her by throwing rocks at her and threat-
ened to kill her by reason of which she says
upon oath that she is afraid they will ~~do her~~
attempt to kill her or do her some serious bod-
ily injury.

These are therefore to command you in the name
of the Commonwealth of Virginia forthwith to
apprehend the said Mary Sheets Celia Wise
and Richard Miller and bring them before me
or some other Justice of the said County to answer
the said complaint and to be further dealt with
according to law.
