

Rockingham County To-wit:

Be it remembered, that on this the 3rd day of August 1874, Richard Donovan, and Frederick Hillegard Senr of the said County Personaley came before me J S Beal Remur, a Justice of the said County and severally and respectively acknowledged themselves to be indebted to the ^{sum} Commonwealth of Virginia, in the manner and following, that is to say:

The said Richard Donovan in the sum of Two hundred Dollars, good and lawful money of the United States, and the said Frederick Hillegard Senr, in the sum of Two hundred Dollars, of like good and lawful money, to be respectively made and levied of their several goods and chattels, lands and tenements, to the use of the Commonwealth of Virginia, if the said Richard Donovan, shall make default in the performance of the under-written condition,

The condition of the above recognizance is such, that if the above bound Richard Donovan, do and shall personally appear on the day of 1874 before the County Court of the said County at the Court house thereof, and then and there answer a bill of indictment

To be referred to the Grand Jury in
and for said County, against him the
Said Richard Donavan, for a misdemeanor
by him committed, for unlawfully
assaulting and beating Martha Jane
Holtz, the wife of Wm H. Holtz, whereof
the Said Richard Donavan stands charged,
and shall not thence depart without
the leave of said Court. Then the above
recognizance shall be void, and of no effect,
otherwise to remain in full force and
virtue.

the 28th day of July 1874, in the Said
County, assault and beat Martha
Jane Jolly, the wife of said
complainant. These are therefore
to command you in the name of
the commonwealth, forthwith to
apprehend and bring before me,
or some other justice of the Said
County, the body of the Said
Richard Donovan, to answer unto the
Said complaint to be further dealt
with according to law.
